Collaboration subjects of the Language Assistant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Maths (for 11-year-olds only), P.E., Art, Physics and Chemistry. <p>Do not worry too much if these are not your thing – you are here to help us with English.</p>
Norms, Resources and Materials for Language Assistant collaboration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The school day starts at 8:10 and finishes at 14:40. Language assistants help us 12 hours a week, normally distributed in four days. We listen to you before we decide how to sort your hours at school. - We expect you to help students speak. That is your basic task! Of course, showing us more about you and your culture is a must. You can check what our previous assistants created for us on our webpage. - Our school etiquette is quite relaxed. We do not wear uniforms and you'll be expected to dress normally – and no, you do not have to teach P.E. or play exhausting games.



<p>Information about the neighborhood and city (video)</p>	<p>Quesada is a picturesque village with a historical centre of white houses and a lot of social life. We live next to the largest natural park in Spain, Sierra de Cazorla, Segura y las Villas. If you are keen on sport, this is your place to be!</p> <p>But culture is also important here, as we have two museums and a flamenco association. And, of course, being a village, you'll have plenty of opportunities for practising your Spanish – people are so welcoming.</p> <p>Of course, you cannot miss our top two tourist attractions, the castle and sanctuary of Tíscar and the Cave of Water.</p> <p>You can find out much more in this link.</p>
<p>Getting to school</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You can reach Quesada by bus from Jaén with Muñoz Amezcua, - It is also possible to travel to/from Quesada to Alicante and Murcia. Check this schedule. - You can share a car with people who offer theirs at Blablacar. This is probably the most flexible way to reach the village and get to faraway places. - We have a local version of Blablacar, called Cococar. People from Quesada, Cazorla and Peal de Becerro are open to share their cars! - Given that around 70% of teachers live in Cazorla or Úbeda, it is most likely that you can get a lift with one of them (free of charge, hopefully – you'll have to talk it over with them!) - Inside the village, you'll need no transport whatsoever. Everything is within walking distance – and you'll get fit!
<p>Accommodation (vídeo)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Where to live in town? - Possibility of staying with a family? - Possibility of sharing a flat with other teachers or language assistants? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Renting a flat is quite inexpensive. Prices start at 250€ per month! We will help you to find a place to stay upon your arrival. - If you prefer sharing, there are teachers, other members of staff and even vocational formation students who would be really happy to do this. And, of course, this is even cheaper than renting on your own. - A third option is to stay with a family. This has never been done before, as renting prices are so low. However, we are pretty sure that there would be people interested in this.
