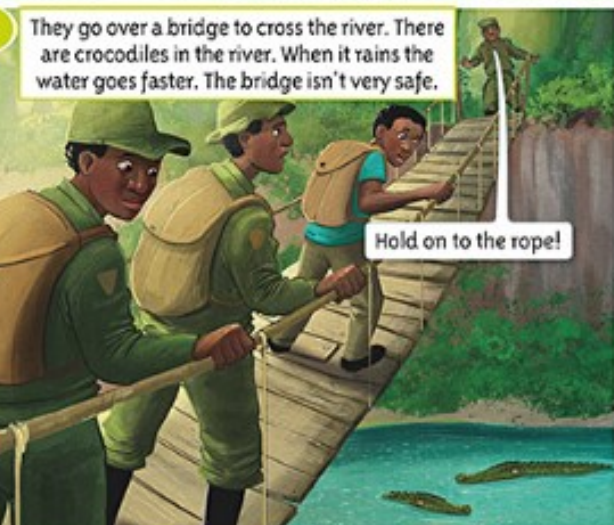
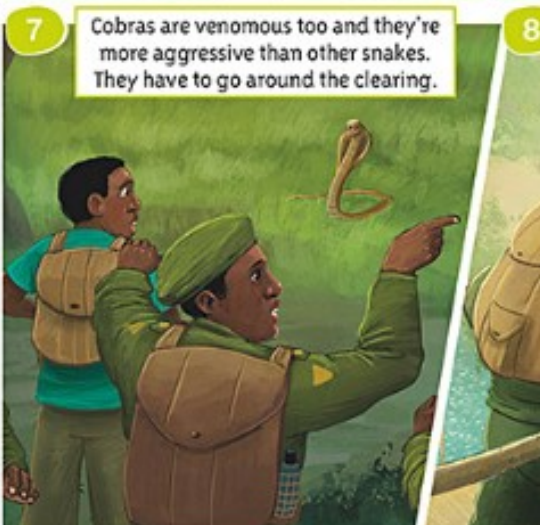

ANIMAL RESCUE

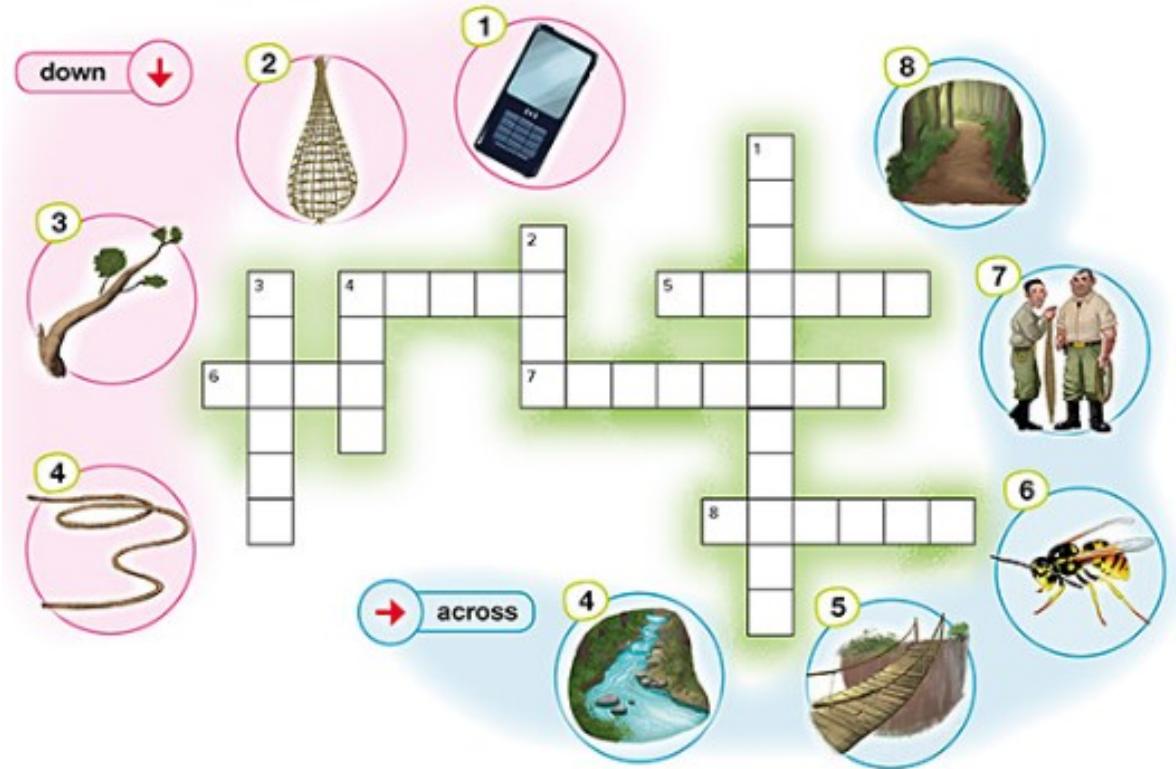
