### HAY

(Se usa “is” para el singular y “are” para el plural).

**Affirmative:**

**THERE IS  
(THERE’S)  
THERE ARE**

There is a man in the room = *Hay un hombre en la habitación.*

There’s some food in the fridge = *Hay comida en el frigorífico.*

There are some apples on the table = *Hay manzanas en la mesa.*

**Negative:**

**THERE IS NOT  
(THERE ISN’T)  
THERE ARE NOT  
(THERE AREN’T)**

There isn’t any bread = *No hay pan.*

There aren’t any oranges = *No hay naranjas.*

**Interrogative:**

**IS THERE?  
ARE THERE?**

Is there a doctor here? = *¿Hay un médico aquí?*

Is there any meat? = *¿Hay carne?*

Are there any eggs? = *¿Hay huevos?*

**Short Answers:**

**YES, THERE IS  
NO, THERE ISN’T**

**YES, THERE ARE  
NO, THERE AREN’T**
