Af.	S + V S + V + -S/-ES/-IES	<u>We work hard.</u> <u>John works</u> as a reporter.
Neg.	S + DON'T + V S + DOESN'T + V	<u>They don't work</u> here. <u>She doesn't work</u> on Saturdays.
Int.	Do + S + V ? Does + S + V ?	<u>Do you work</u> in an office? <u>Does Jane work</u> today?
S.A.	Yes, + Pron. + DO / DOES No, + Pron. + DON'T DOESN'T	Yes, I do / Yes, he does No, we don't No, she doesn't
Q.W.	What <u>do</u> you <u>do</u> ? ¿A qué te dedicas?	What <u>does</u> Tom <u>do</u> ? ¿A qué se dedica Tom?

WANT TO + V

(querer hacer algo)

El artículo "a" va siempre delante de las profesiones en sing.

Affirmative: I want to be a writer. (Quiero ser escritor, -a)

Negative: She doesn't want to work as a secretary.
(Ella no quiere trabajar de secretaria).

Interrogative: What do you want to be when you grow up? (¿Qué quieres ser de mayor?)

- What's your job? → I'm an electrician.

¿En qué trabajas? Soy electricista.

- Where do you work? → I work in a factory.

¿Dónde trabajas? Trabajo en una fábrica.
