What tools did humans use in the Neolithic Age?

People still used stone to make weapons and tools. By rubbing stones together, the surface of some tools became highly polished. During the Neolithic Age, people made ceramic objects from clay or mud. They used ceramic utensils for carrying and storing food and often decorated them. There is also evidence that human beings started to make textiles from wool, and to use cane for basket weaving.

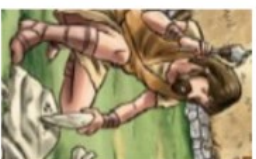

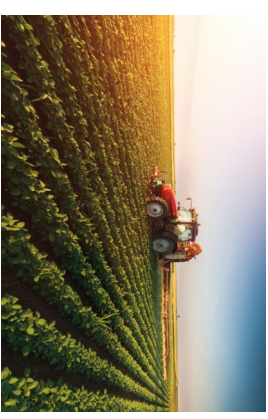
