It is positioned between the mountains of Sierra Filabres and the Mediterranean sea. There is a population of ~2,000 people. 	<p>To pass time outside of the school, there are dancing, kick-boxing, cooking, and spanish classes, a rail trail “Via Verde,” hiking trails www.alltrails.com, a fully equipped gym with a range of exercise classes offered, 6 authentic spanish restaurants, and a history museum. Serón is also a bus ride away from the prominent cities of Almeria and Granada.</p>
