Macael is a town in Almería that is famous for its large amount of marble. There is a Guinness record of a mortar of 50,000 kg.








ALMERÍA: THE CAPITAL ALMERÍA CLIMATE

POPULATION OF ALMERÍA

On January 1, 2023, the population of the city of Almería was 201,775 inhabitants.





FLORA

Almería is one of the areas with the greatest biodiversity in Europe.

There are more than 3,000 species of vascular plants catalogued, the flora being one of the richest on the European continent.

We have a large number of endemic plants that are species that are only found here or that are distributed over a small area that includes our province.











FAIR

The Almería Fair is the big festival of our city, it begins two Fridays before the last Sunday in August, lasts nine days and is celebrated in honor of the Virgin of the Sea. We have a night fair and a midday fair. The midday fair is made up of street bars known as "ambigús", stalls at street level with music, dancing and performances throughout the center of Almería.







HISTORICAL CURIOSITIES

The town of Los Millares is the oldest city in Spain. It is located 22 kilometers from Almería capital.



5,200 years ago, during the Copper Age, 1,500 people lived there.


