Classic Pancake Recipe!

- ★ 1 Egg
- ★ 1 Cup of all Purpose Flour
- ★ 1 tablespoon of sugar
- ★ 3 teaspoons of baking powder
- ★ ¼ teaspoon of salt
- ★ ¾ cup of milk
- ★ 2 tablespoons of vegetable oil or melted butter
