¿Para quién es este Basic English Vocabulary Guide: Content and Crosscurricular basic vocabulary for bilingual secondary Schools A-Z?

Está indicado para el profesorado de ANL (áreas no lingüísticas) y AL (áreas lingüísticas) de Secundaria y Bachillerato de centros bilingües y plurilingües. El profesorado de refuerzo y el que realiza adaptaciones curriculares puede encontrar en estas páginas una valiosa ayuda. También puede ser usado por cualquier estudiante de nivel intermedio-avanzado que quiera trabajar autónomamente para ampliar su vocabulario.

¿Qué temas incluimos?

Este no es un diccionario convencional, sino una presentación de los conceptos básicos de las asignaturas del currículo y los temas transversales en el proceso de transformación que se está llevando a cabo en los centros bilingües. Resulta ideal en contextos educativos que afrontan los cambios organizativos del currículo integrado pues incluimos el léxico básico de todas las áreas y temas transversales en Inglés en ordenación alfabética. El currículo integrado exige un mayor grado de compromiso, consenso y coordinación del profesorado y unos nuevos métodos, procedimientos y tareas. Constituye una magnífica oportunidad para el profesorado experimentado y el alumnado aprende más cuando se hace una integración curricular efectiva que cuando estudia las asignaturas por separado (curriculum fragmentado). Fue James Beane quien presentó un modelo de curriculum integrado y negociado entre todos los sectores educativos ofreciendo una visión holística, coherente y más significativa (procesual) de la enseñanza/aprendizaje. El currículo integrado demanda un sobreesfuerzo del profesorado, mayor tiempo para coordinarse y, en algunos casos, agrupamientos flexibles, lo cual cambia radicalmente la cultura escolar convencional.

La enseñanza de idiomas a principios del siglo XXI ha de usar contenidos más amplios interdisciplinares y multidisciplinares, content-based language teaching-, no meramente lingüísticos y ha de atender las múltiples inteligencias posibles del alumnado y el profesorado aplicando el Marco Común Europeo de Referencia para las Lenguas y el Portafolio Europeo de las Lenguas.

Sugerencias para usar el vocabulario en el aula

Es preciso ir más allá de la mera conexión entre materias diversas (enseñanza interdisciplinar) hay que ver el proceso de enseñanza aprendizaje como un todo global y significativo que nos acerque al mundo real.

Para cada uno de los temas podemos realizar actividades distintas en su explotación en clase o aplicar una actividad que funcione en un tema a otro tema:

- 1) Hallar vínculos entre materias aparentemente desconectadas: Música y Química; Francés y Matemáticas; Tecnologías e Interculturalidad, etc.
- 2) Realizar juegos memorísticos en Educación para el consumidor del tipo alfabético: I went to the supermarket and I bought (food and drink, fruit, spices). Encadenar una lista de compras de la A a la Z. Esta actividad puede hacerse oralmente o por escrito (o ambas a la vez).
- 3) Leer un tema cualquiera y subrayar en rojo las palabras que no conocen y en verde las que sí conocen (cognates).
- 4) Realizar un quiz o test de cada tema estudiado adaptando el vocabulario al nivel.
- 5) En Biology o Physical education separar conceptos fundamentales de otros más triviales.
- 6) Relacionar objetos o lugares de trabajo con profesiones. Asignar un oficio a cada alumno asociándolo por criterios alfabéticos.
- 7) Clasificar (ropa por ejemplo) en la categoría correcta (caballero, señora o niño, por ejemplo).
- 8) Añadir items que puedan faltar en cualquiera de las materias.
- 9) Traducir directamente al francés, alemán o español.
- 10) Confeccionar tu propio horario en el tema school subjects.
- 11) Reordenar alfabéticamente donde proceda.
- 12) Definición términos filosóficos (ismos) y relacionarlos con científicos (Orden)
- 13) Relacionar países con idiomas que se hablan en ellos.
- 14) Buscar equivalencias en los términos de etimología común.
- 15) Organizar un vocabulario alternativo A-Z con ciudades españolas, francesas o alemanas.
- 16) Práctica oral en Sports, Food, etc. Por ejemplo: "I like X but I don't like Y", o también práctica escrita con los nombres de los alumnos y sus preferencias en Subjects, Sports, Food, Television Programmes, etc.
- 17) Crear un texto asociando climas y estaciones con plantas y flores.
- 18) Buscar sinónimos y antónimos en el tema que se preste a ello.
- 19) Relacionar la cultura americana con las imágenes de cultura andaluza.
- 20) Asociar colores a los conceptos de un tema dado.(sinestesia)
- 21) Crear un crucigrama o sopa de letras con distintos temas.
- 22) Reorganizar las festividades y celebraciones cronológicamente en un calendario.
- 23) Elaborar un árbol genealógico que incluya el mayor parentesco posible (entre las distintas materias)
- 24) En medios de transporte elaborar un diagrama con aquellos usados por nuestros alumnos y su frecuencia (usar adverbios de frecuencia).
- 25) Colaborar con los profesores de música en Musical instruments.
- 26) Trabajar con los de Física y Química en Scientific research.
- 27) Emplear la respuesta Física total en Physical Education /Body.
- 28) Crear un Cuestionario verdadero / falso.
- 29) Inventariar prejuicios sobre una cultura determinada y modos de erradicarlos.
- 30) Mis términos preferidos empiezan por: S, H, R, L, A, F, etc.(creatividad léxica).

También podemos utilizar una ficha vacía A-Z para que el alumnado elabore su propio campo léxico sobre un determinado tema. Otra sugerencia sería dejar la ficha rellena cinco minutos, retirarla y que, individualmente, o en parejas los alumnos trataran de rellenar la ficha en blanco. Finalmente, en niveles intermedios o avanzados podemos pedir a los alumnos que escriban una redacción sobre cualquiera de los temas que se presentan colores, ropas, animales, ordenadores, familia, etc.

Hemos adjuntado al final una serie de acrónimos educativos con una doble finalidad: primeramente, para conocimiento de la compleja realidad educativa; y en segundo lugar, como divertimento o ejercicio lúdico que estimula la imaginación y la creatividad del alumnado.
