## PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE OR PAST SIMPLE?

PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE	PAST SIMPLE
FOR, SINCE For a period of time still continuing	FOR For a period of time which is finished
"I've lived in Granada FOR four years" (I still live here in Gr.)	"I lived in Granada FOR four years" (I don't live here now)
Question: <b>HOW LONG</b> .	Question: WHEN.
"How long have you lived in Granada?" (I know you still live here)	"When did you live in Granada?" (It happened in the past)
STILL, YET	AGO
For unfinished actions or events. (Still and Yet are <u>always negative</u> in the P.Perf)	For completed actions and events in the past
"I still haven't finished it" "I haven't finished it yet"	"I finished it one hour ago"
JUST For events that happened in the recent past.  "Flight 205 has JUST landed" or	For events that happened at a particular time in the past.  "Flight 205 landed at one o'clock"
"Flight 205 has landed" (In the last minutes)	
When the time stated is not finished.	When the time stated is finished.
"I've spent the morning studying English" (It's still morning)	"I spent the morning studying English"  (It's afternoon now)
With adverbs like: ALREADY, BEFORE,	
EVER AND NEVER.	
"I've done it before"	
"I've never done it"	
"I've already done it"	
"Nobody has ever done it"	
(Before goes after the verb)
