STUDYING ABROAD, p.58

HOW TO KEEP FRIENDS, p.62

1. Sometimes, we see that people are **not** very different from us **FALSE**
2. Sometimes, we haven't got time for our friends because we are busy **TRUE**
3. Remember your friends are good for your health **TRUE**

KEEPING COOL, p.67

1. The air conditioner was invented by Stuart Cramer **FALSE (Lo inventó Willis Carrier)**
2. The first private house with air conditioning was invented in the cinema **FALSE (no tiene sentido y no es lo que dice el texto)**
3. From 1930 to 1939, Americans often went to cinema in the summer **TRUE (In the 1930s significa la década de los años 30 y eso es 1930-39)**
4. It is true to say that air conditioners haven't been an important factor in US geography **FALSE (Sí es un factor importante)**

ELECTRIC KETTLE, p.70

1. Always put the kettle in water **FALSE (En el texto es negativo, aquí está en afirmativo)**
2. You must try to repair the kettle yourself **FALSE (Igual que la anterior)**
3. After the kettle is connected to the electricity, turn it on **TRUE**
4. Disconnect the kettle from the electricity and then clean it **TRUE (Aunque está explicado con otras palabras, expresa lo mismo que en el texto en la última oración)**

THINGS YOU NEVER KNEW ABOUT SHOES, p.75

1. People who lived in hot places needed their shoes to protect their feet **FALSE** (Es en lugares cold, no hot)
2. Some women died after falling from their shoes in the 17th century **FALSE** (No fue en el S XVII sino en el XVI - mira a la derecha)
3. At the beginning of the 17th century, boots became very fashionable for men **TRUE**

BLACK FRIDAY, p.78

1. Black Friday isn't one of the most important shopping days of the year **FALSE** (Sí lo es)
2. There are big discounts on Black Friday **TRUE**
3. The discount on jewelry is bigger than the discount on film CDs **FALSE** (Las joyas tienen menos descuento -4%- que las pelis, etc. -28%-)
