

A1 Directions And Giving Directions

Asking for directions:

- Excuse me, where is the post office?
- Excuse me, where is the bank?
- Can you help me, please?

Giving directions – Useful phrases:

• Go straight this street	• Go to the end of the street.
• Turn left.	• It is next to the park.
• Turn right.	• It is opposite the school.
• Turn left on the first/second street.	• It is near the square.
• Turn right at the corner.	• It is between the bank and the café.
• Go past the museum.	• It is on the left / It is on the right

• bank → banco	• road → carretera / calle
• supermarket → supermercado	• square → plaza
• school → colegio / escuela	• corner → esquina
• hospital → hospital	• roundabout → rotonda
• museum → museo	• traffic lights → semáforo(s)
• park → parque	• bridge → puente
• café → cafetería	• crossing → cruce / paso
• police station → comisaría	• block → manzana

Example conversation:

A: Excuse me, where is the museum? B: Go straight and go past the park. Turn right at the corner. The museum is opposite the café. A: Thank you very much. B: No problem.
