El **present perfect** se forma con:

Sujeto + **have / has + participio pasado**

Se usa para:

Acciones que ocurrieron en un momento no específico del pasado

Experiencias de vida

Acciones que empezaron en el pasado y continúan ahora

Ejemplo:

I have finished my homework.
