Resumen:

Uso del gerundio:

- 1) Como sujeto al inicio de la oración: Running is healthy, Swimming is fun.
- 2) Después de algunos verbos como like, love, hate, enjoy: I like running, They enjoy dancing.
- 3) Después de preposiciones como in, on, at, about: I am interested in speaking English, She is good at playing tennis.
