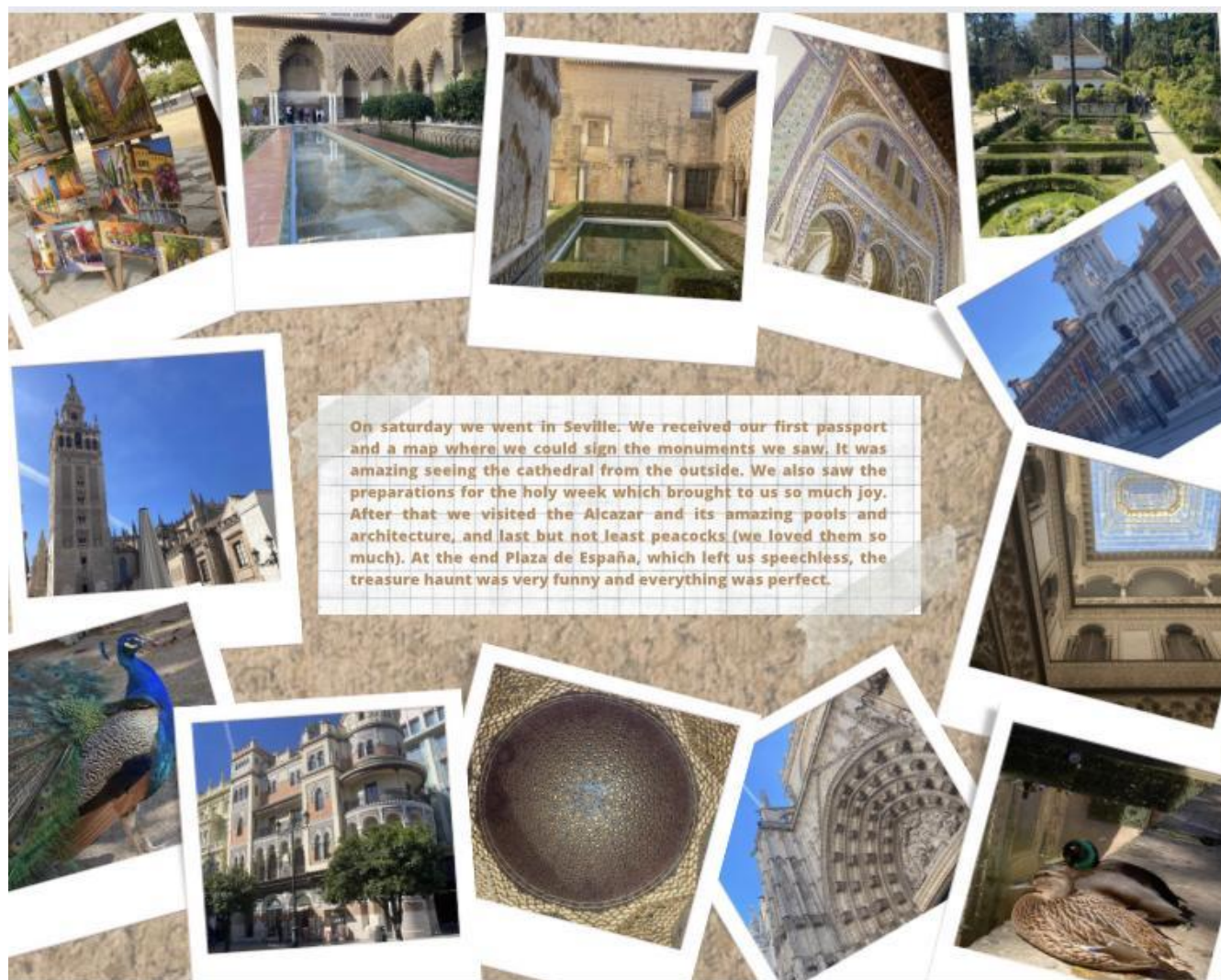


## DIARY 10th - 17th MARCH ERASMUS

### *CERAMIC WORKSHOP: LOLA AND GINEVRA*

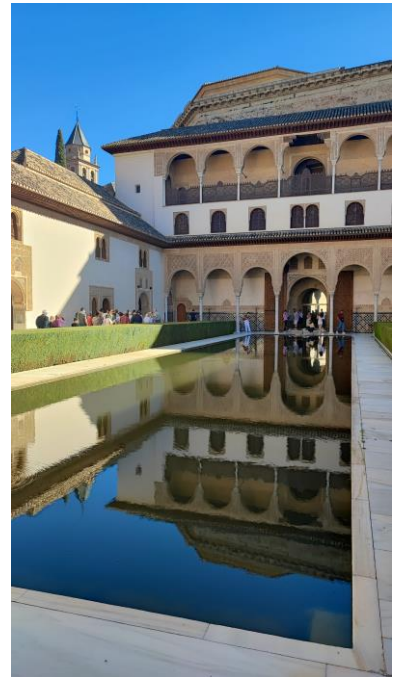
*On Tuesday we were in a workshop. During it, we made typical tiles from Spain with the help of the art's teacher. We had a lot of fun!*
