


From Amberg to Gothenburg

Gothenburg

- Swedish city
- ~920 km as the crow flies distance from Amberg
- about 570 000 inhabitants
- Alla vägar bär till Gøtheborg!
▶ All roads lead to Gothenburg



By ferry

At first you have to drive by train from Amberg to Kiel with a stop in Nuremburg and Hamburg.

After the 8 hours from the first step of the trip you will arrive at the main railway station in Kiel.

Then you have to go to the port and check in on one of the ships of the StenaLine company.



From here, you can relax and chill for about 13 hours.

All in all, this trip is about 480€.

The most negative point is the ecological aspect because ships are producing one of the highest fumes.

By train



The first station you begin your trip is in Amberg and ends in Nuremburg, it's on of the shortest parts of the trip with about 1 hour.

After that you go from Nuremburg to Hamburg in 5 hours and go on to Flensburg with another 2 hours.

Then you arrive in Denmark at midnight, exactly in Frederica and after a stay of about 2 hours you continue to Copenhagen and arrive there 3 hours later.

From there you go to Sweden and arrive at first in Malmö.

The last station is Gothenburg Central so that you arrive there after 3 hours.

All in all the trip takes about 19 hours and costs about 120€.

It is ecological better for the earth because it's public transport.

By plane

Your journey starts at the train-station in Amberg. From there you take the train to Nuremberg. You have to change there to the subway in the direction to the airport. After arriving you have to check in and take off to Berlin Tegel. You have 50 minutes to get the flight to Gothenburg and you'll arrive there after about 4 hours from your start at Amberg .

It's maybe a comfortable way to get from Amberg to Gothenburg by plane but it's also a negative way because of the kerosene.

You have to pay about 320€ for the whole trip.



By car

Another way to get from Amberg to Gothenburg is to drive by car. Therefore you have to go from Amberg along the A3. After that you continue on the A7 and A1 to Lübeck there you have to spend a night.

After a night in a wonderful city you drive to Puttgarden and take the ferry to Rødby Sogn.



From there you drive along the E20 and the E6 straight to Gothenburg.

Your trip takes about 22 hours with a relaxing night in Lübeck.

The emissions for driving by car is better than taking the plane.

How much you have to pay depends on how ecofriendly you drive.

By bike

Our last suggestion for you is to drive by bike.
