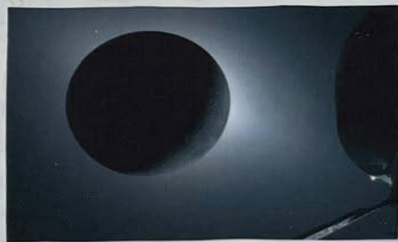
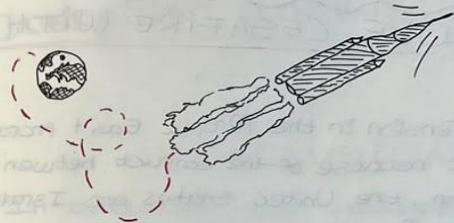
ARTEMIS II: THE NEW SPACE RACE.

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→ NASA's Artemis II mission isn't only about returning to the moon, but also about global power. The United States wants to show that it is still the leader in space exploration while countries like China and Russia continue developing their own lunar programs.

→ The group, that were formed by Reid Wiseman, Victor Glover, Christina Koch and the Canadian astronaut Jeremy Hansen, travelled deep into space and explored areas near the far side of the Moon. The mission also showed cooperation between the United States and Canada, making alliances in the new space race.



→ Experts believe the Moon could become very important in the future because of its resources and its role in future missions to Mars. For this reason, Artemis II is seen as both a scientific mission and a geopolitical competition between world powers.

THE NAGORNO

The Nagorno-Karabakh conflict is a territorial dispute between Azerbaijan and Armenia. This territory is internationally recognized as part of Azerbaijan, but it was occupied by Armenian forces after the collapse of the Soviet Union, along with Shusha and Lachin (May 1992), Kalbajar (April 1993), Aghdam (July 1993), Jabrayil and Qubadli (August 1993), and Zangilan (October 1993).

During the war (1991-1994), there were massive displacements of the Azerbaijani population and serious violations of international humanitarian law, including the Khojaly massacre. As a result, many Azerbaijanis were expelled from the region.

International organizations such as the United Nations have adopted resolutions recognizing the territorial integrity of Azerbaijan and calling for the withdrawal of Armenian forces. However, the conflict remained frozen after a ceasefire in 1994, with on going tensions and repeated violations.

KARABAKH CONFLICT

Finally, the text argues that the conflict remains unresolved because the Armenian government is unwilling to change the current situation. It claims that maintaining the conflict serves as an excuse to control its population and stay in power.

It also states that Armenia faces economic difficulties and that improving its situation would depend on cooperation with Azerbaijan. Therefore, it concludes that, to achieve peace, Armenia should withdraw its troops from the disputed territories as a first step.

PUTIN REFUSES PUTIN REFUSES

WHAT HAS HAPPENED?

Vladimir Putin refused and said that it has no sense in meeting with the Ukrainian president Zelensky after offering the end of the war between Russia and Ukraine.

WHY DID PUTIN REFUSE THE OFFER?

Last Thursday, Zelensky asked Putin to negotiate, writing that "there is no need to wait" for the war to become once again USA's loss.

Apart from that, Zelensky asked for a ceasefire with a mocking tone. Vladimir Putin responded that it was a rude note and he declined the offer of meeting with Zelensky.

WHAT DID THEY SAY?

Putin last Friday in the Russia's annual economic forum in St. Petersburg was asked about if he will accept the Zelensky's offer, and he said: "I don't see any point for war". When the Ukrainian president heard the Putin's speech, he replied saying "he just doesn't want to end the war. I think that many people were disappointed by this answer".

Putin restated his position, saying that a ceasefire would only allow Ukraine to regroup with the other countries. Later, he said that they would end the war when they finish their goals. Apart from that, he threatened Ukraine saying them to not even try to join the OTAN, something that Zelensky replied with comments like: "After 25 years in power, age is beginning to take its toll".

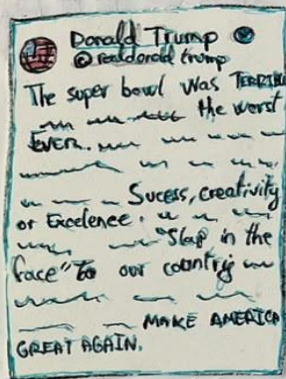
-THE SUPER BOWL-

THE STRAIT OF HORMUZ

WHAT IS THE STRAIT OF HORMUZ?

The strait of Hormuz is a maritime channel between 38 and 95 km wide which is located between the Gulf of Oman and the Persian Gulf (rich in oil). It's controlled by Iran and it's one of the most important strategic points of the global maritime transport. That's where about 20% of the global production of Oil and other sources of non-renewable energy like liquefied gas passes.

WHY IT IS A NEW ?

A crisis has occurred because of Iran's decision to close the strait of Hormuz on March 2nd, 2026 threatening to attack all the ships that try to pass.



WHY HAS IT BEEN CLOSED ?

Iran closed the strait of Hormuz because of the US and Israeli attacks in Iranian territory that also caused the death of their leader, Ali Khamenei and many more deaths.



WHAT ARE THE CONSEQUENCES?

The closure of the strait doesn't allow the passage of ships. Unfortunately, the 20% of the oil and liquefied gas pass through this strait, so the prices of these sources increase and consequently fuels, food... prices are also rising provoking a global economy and energy crisis.

CURRENT SITUATION?

Nowadays the strait of Hormuz is still partially closed (it isn't closed for all the ships) with strict border control. Despite having tried to fully reopen the strait 3 times (last time was May 4th, 2026). Global powers like China are actually trying to fully reopen the strait once again.
