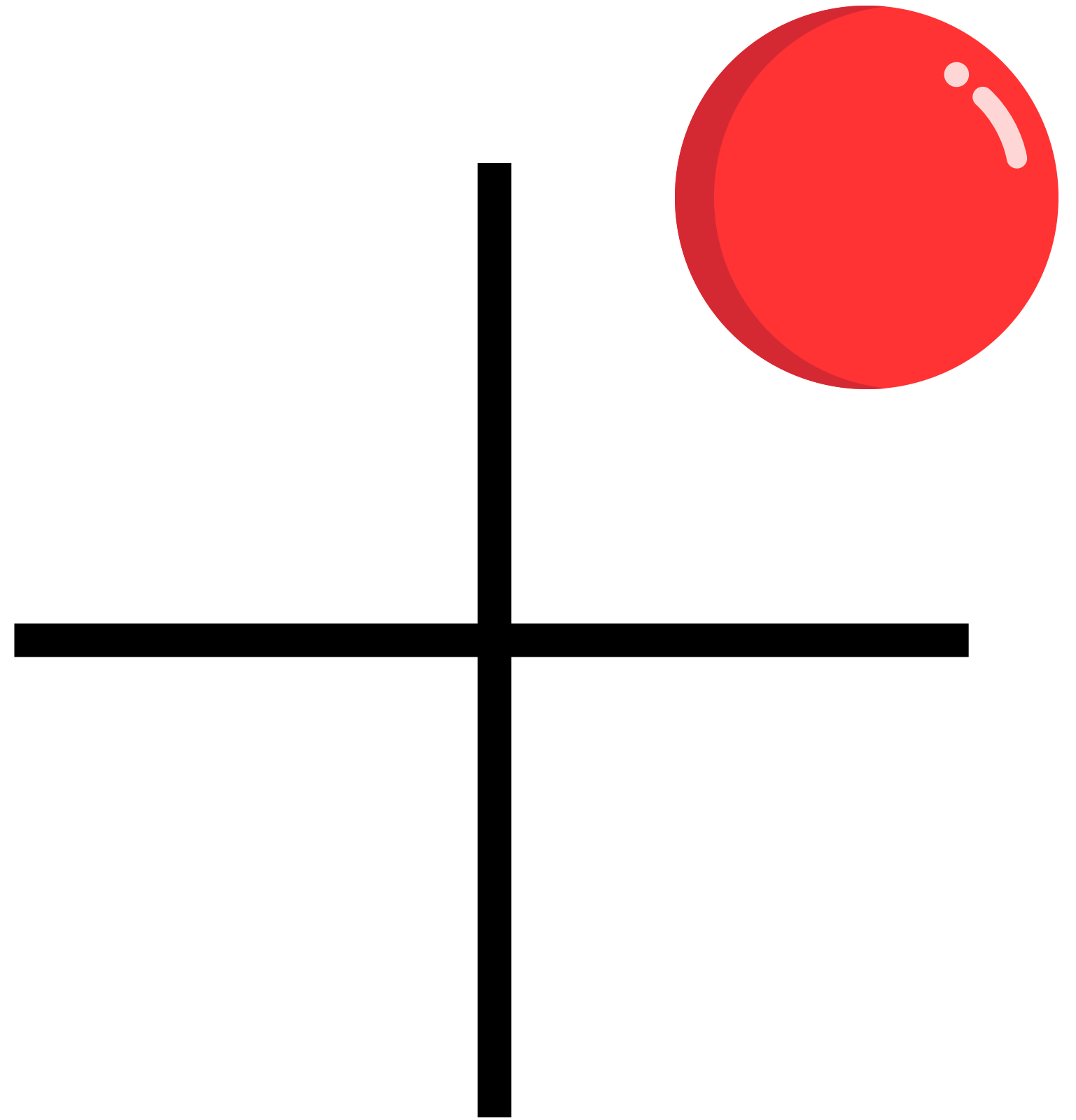


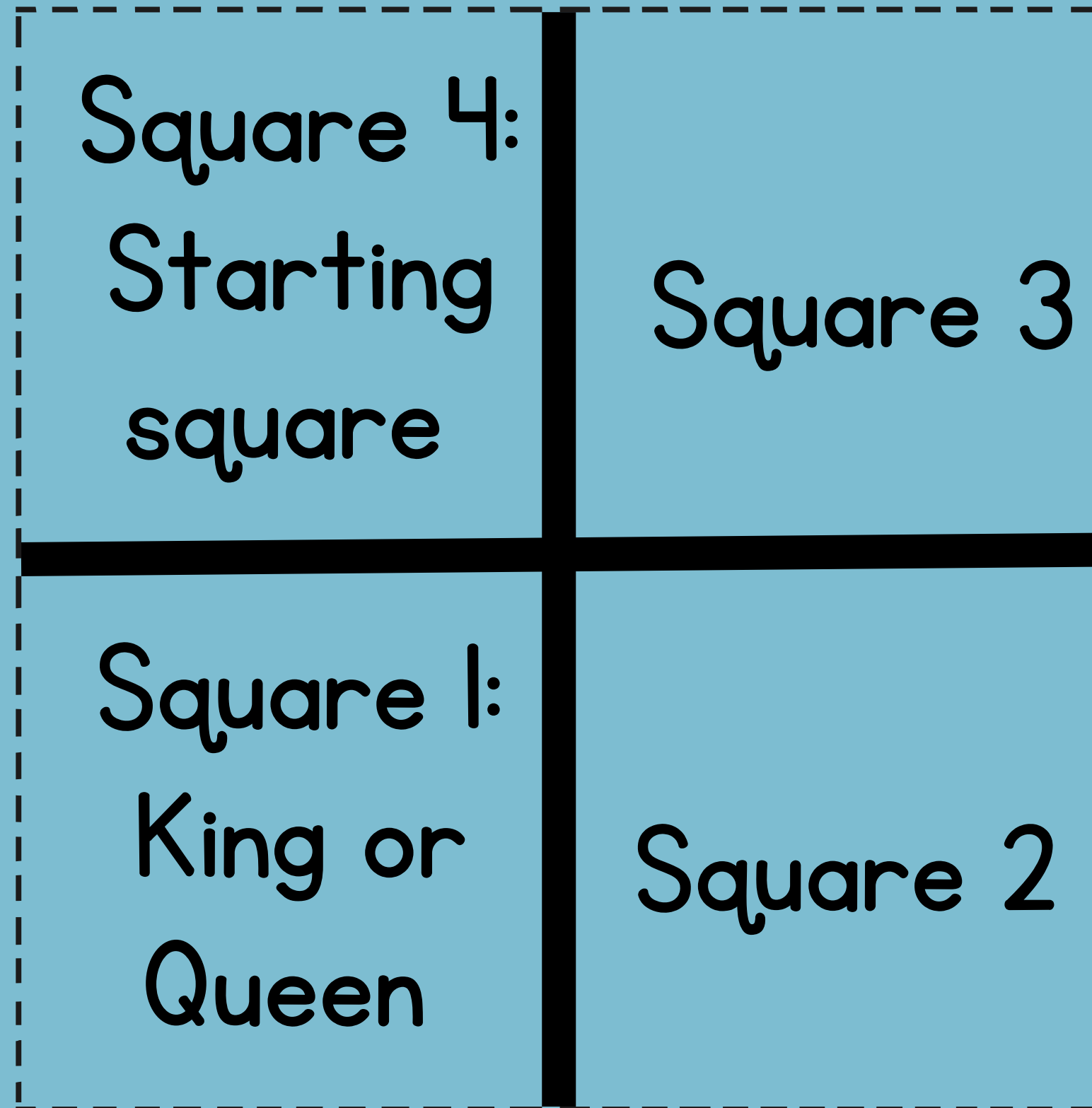
FOUR SQUARE



WHAT IS FOUR SQUARE?

- A FUN BALL GAME PLAYED ON A SQUARE COURT DIVIDED INTO 4 SMALLER SQUARES.
- EACH SQUARE HAS A PLAYER. (YOU CAN HAVE MORE STUDENTS WAITING IN LINE TO JOIN!)
- THE GOAL: STAY IN THE GAME AND MOVE UP TO SQUARE 1 (THE TOP SQUARE).

The Court:



Basic Rules

- Players hit the ball by bouncing it (like a volleyball hit) into another square.
- The ball must bounce once in another player's square.
- That player must hit it into a different square before it bounces twice.

How you lose

A player is out if:

- The ball bounces twice in their square.
- They hit the ball out of the court.
- They hit the ball into their own square.
- They catch or hold the ball.

When a player is out:

- They go to the back of the line.
- Everyone moves up:
Square 4 \rightarrow 3, 3 \rightarrow 2, 2 \rightarrow 1.
- A new player comes into Square 4.

Helpful vocab:

- Square = cuadro
- Bounce = botar
- Hit = golpear
- Out = fuera
- Court = pista
