Our training

• Higher Technician in Early Childhood Education

Students acquire the skills to intervene in the formal field of early childhood education with boys and girls from 0 to 3 years old, and in the non-formal field up to 6 years old, designing, implementing and evaluating child care programs.

At a professional level, you can perform the following jobs:

- Child educators in centers and 0 to 3 years.
- Educator in institutions and/or in specific work programs with minors (0-6 years) in a situation of social risk
- Educator in programs or activities of leisure and free time for children with children from 0 to 6 years old: play centers, houses of culture, libraries, educational centers, leisure centers, school farms, etc.

• Higher Technician in Social Integration

Through this training, gli studenti acquires no competence to intervene with people and groups in situations of social risk (anziani, disabled, tossicodipendenti, migrant, minor, adolescent...).

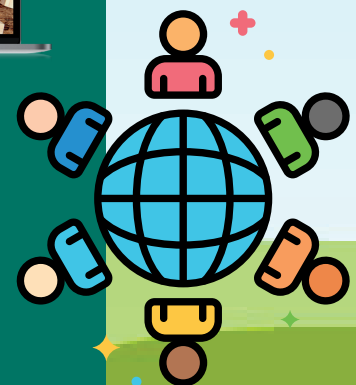

• Higher Technician in Sociocultural and Tourist Animation

At the training level, students acquire skills to design, implement and evaluate cultural, tourist, recreational, environmental projects and activities... Work with children, young people, the elderly, people with disabilities and groups at risk of exclusion, promoting the use and enjoy community resources.

At a professional level, you can perform the following jobs:

- Coordination and/or direction of free educational time for children and youth
- Coordination of camps, school farms, nature schools...
- Sociocultural, cultural and hotel entertainer or entertainer
- Manager or manager of associations
- Technician or community technician



Our educational center



Our institute is located in the municipality of Fuengirola, located 30 km southwest of the city of Malaga, on the Costa del Sol with a population of more than 80,000 inhabitants.

It is a tourist and cosmopolitan town, welcoming more than 30% of the population from countries such as the United Kingdom, Ireland, Finland, Morocco or Argentina.

The IES Santiago Ramón y Cajal in Fuengirola is located about 500 meters from the sea and in the western part of the city. It was built in 1983 as the former Fuengirola Vocational Training Institute.

In addition to Secondary and Bacalaureate education, our institute has professional training, highlighting the professional family of Sociocultural and Community Services, which has offered training cycles for more than 20 years. Your offer is made up of:

- Technician in Care for People in a Dependency Situation
- Higher Technician of Early Childhood Education
- Senior Technician in Social Integration
- Higher Technician in Sociocultural and Tourist Animation, offered for the first time in the 2022-23 academic year

In addition, it has other training cycles such as Telecommunications, Electrical Installations and basic professional training in Cooking and Catering for people with disabilities.
