Getting to school	It is complicated to take the public transport, but you have two options:  - Live in town and enjoy nature. Rent is around 300 euros per month.  - Come to school and go back to Seville in a car with other teachers. Most of them live in Seville and towns around the city and they share their cars (one week each). It takes them like 35 minutes to come here.  In case you would like to come with them by car, you would probably have to pay something for it (40-50 euros per month).

- Possibility of sharing a flat with teachers?	If you would like to live in the city, Seville, the rent is more expensive. A studio flat for one person could cost at least 500 euros. It would be cheaper if you share a flat with other people (students or workers). The price, obviously, will depend on the area or district where you stay. The best places in the city are the city centre and Triana. They have good connections when coming to school every morning.
