<p>Information about the town and/or neighborhood*</p> <p>*pictures below chart</p>	<p>- El Castillo de las Guardas is a rural small town, located about 58 kilometres from Seville. It has about 1500 inhabitants. If they live in this village, they can enjoy nature, animals, hiking,... If they live in Seville, there many more options. In fact, they have everything a city can offer: museums, sport clubs, cinemas, shopping centres, pubs, clubs,...</p> <p>https://youtu.be/FizXrrNLUXM</p> <p>If they decide to stay here in El Castillo de las Guardas, there are some teachers who rent a house, since they usually live far away from here, and in the evenings they go hiking and enjoy nature. People from El Castillo, like in any other small places, are very kind and friendly.</p> <p>There is a Nature Reserve here in town, where you can enjoy animals, plants, nature and lots of activities. <p>Getting to school</p>	<p>It is complicated to take the public transport, but you have two options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Live in town and enjoy nature. Rent is around 300 euros per month. - Come to school and go back to Seville in a car with other teachers. Most of them live in Seville and towns around the city and they share their cars (one week each). It takes them like 35 minutes to come here. <p>In case you would like to come with them by car, you would probably have to pay something for it (40-50 euros per month).</p>
<p>Accommodation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Where to live in town? - Possibility of staying with a family? - Possibility of sharing a flat with teachers? 	<p>If you are interested in renting a house in El Castillo, you can mail us and we can help you with that. Like it was said before, renting a house is like 300 euros per month. If you share the house with another teacher you would pay just the half (150 more or less).</p> <p>If you would like to live in the city, Seville, the rent is more expensive. A studio flat for one person could cost at least 500 euros. It would be cheaper if you share a flat with other people (students or workers). The price, obviously, will depend on the area or district where you stay. The best places in the city are the city centre and Triana. 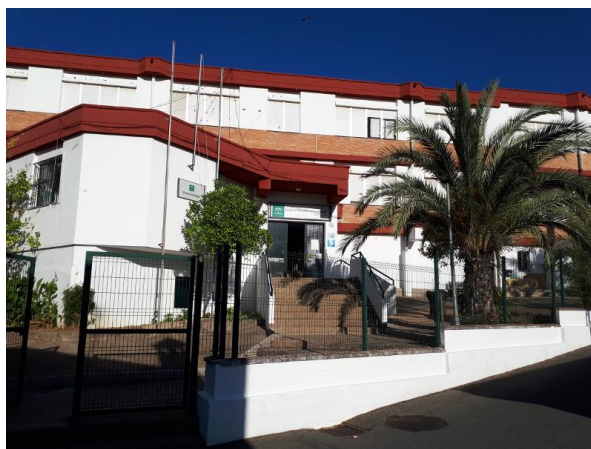
