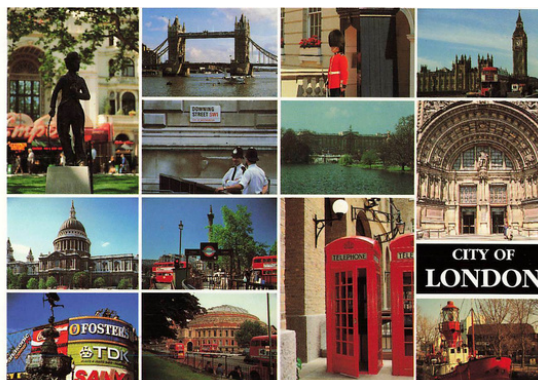

1 ROCHESTER

Here our students went to Sweeps Festival in Kent, which is one of the biggest cultural traditions in the district and celebrates the coming of spring in a three-day affair unlike any other.

2 BROADSTAIRS

Ramsgate Coastal walk is a gentle coastal walk linking 3 historic coastal towns (Margate, Broadstairs, Ramsgate) on the Isle of Thanet (NE Kent). Much of the walk is along low chalk cliffs with views over the channel, with several secluded coves.

6 DOVER CASTLE

Dover Castle is a medieval castle in Dover, Kent.

It was founded in the 11th century and has been described as the "Key to England" due to its defensive significance throughout history. Some writers say it is the largest castle in England,
