Felipe II rey de España, Sicilia, Nápoles y Portugal

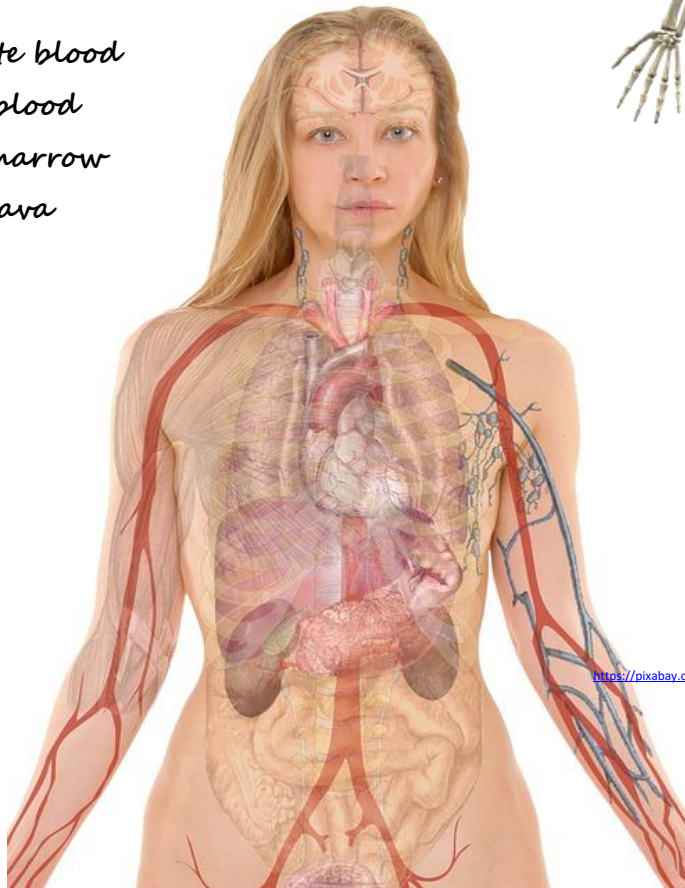
nacido en 1527, tuvo el mayor imperio de la historia de España
