


Martin Luther (1483-1546) launches his 95 Thesis.

The Protestant Reformation begins.


Charles (1500-1558)

and the conquest of Mexico.




Ferdinand Magellan (1480-1521),


Pope Leo excommunicates

The Spanish conquistador seizes the Inca empire for Spain and names the territory Peru.



A major advance in the history of **anatomy**.

Miguel Servet (1511 - 1553), Spanish Renaissance humanist and participant in the Protestant Reformation publishes his book Restoration of Christianity

publishes La Galatea, his first book.


Philip II (1527-1598)



(The Cosmographic Mystery.)


