**SUBJECT** + **MUSTN'T** + **VERB**

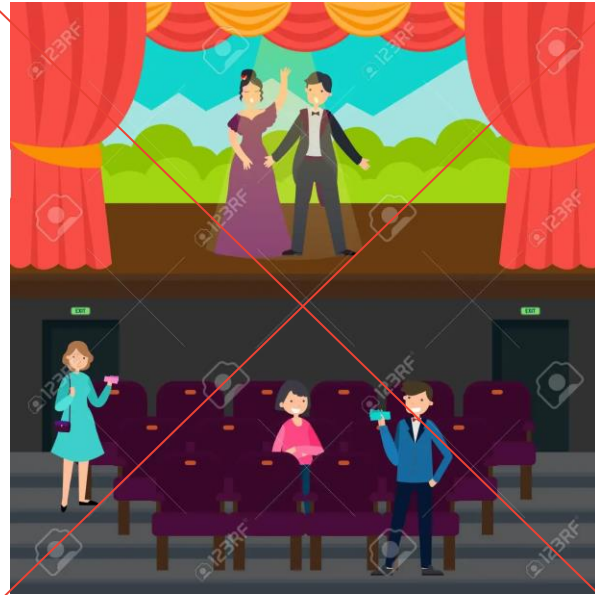

They **MUSTN'T** stand inside the cinema while the show is on.

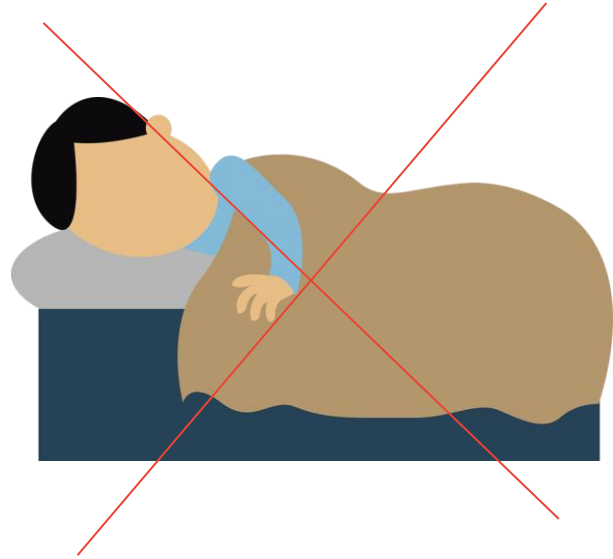






MUSTN'T
