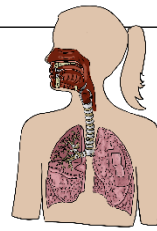

**THE RESPIRATORY
SYSTEM**

Match the parts to the correct information

MOUTH and NOSE:

openings that pull air from
outside your body

EPIGLOTTIS:

closes to stop food from
going into the trachea.

LARYNX:

It is also called voice box, it
is the top part of the air-only
pipe

LARYNX:

It contains a pair of vocal
cords, which vibrate to
make sounds

TRACHEA:

flexible airway tube that
links the larynx to the
bronchi.

BRONCHI:

tubes at the bottom of your trachea that connect into each lung

BRONCHIOLES:

small branches of the bronchi that end in the alveoli.

RIGHT LUNG:

it is larger and has 3 lobes

LEFT LUNG:

It has 2 lobes and it is smaller

PLEURA:

a two-layered membrane that covers each lung
