

Ragtime

Style of piano music that was popular from 1896-1918 and originated in Midwest cities by black piano players

First American Music

It is sometimes considered the first American music because it was a new genre created within America, not brought with from another country.

some consider it a synthesis of African rhythms and European classical music.



elements of these genres are combined to form...

Ragtime is characterized by...

The actual melody is less important than the syncopated, jumpy rhythms

beat, making them sound somewhat unexpected and off beat

The result is a sound that is...

good for dancing, choppy, springy, lively






