Easter occurs on “the first Sunday after the full Moon that occurs on or after the spring equinox.”

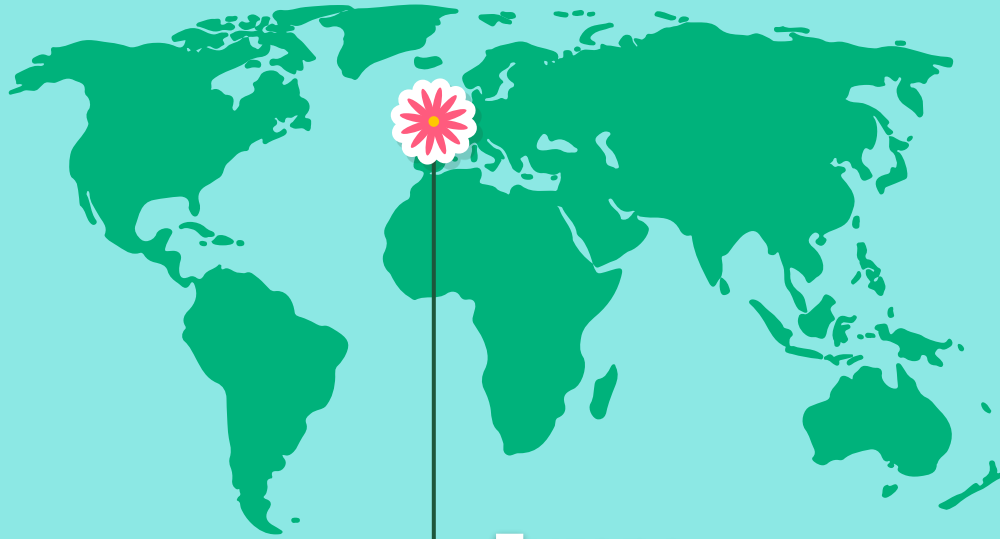

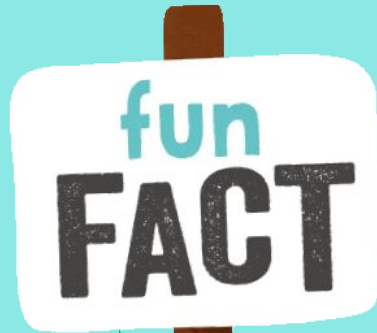


CHOCOLATE BUNNY
