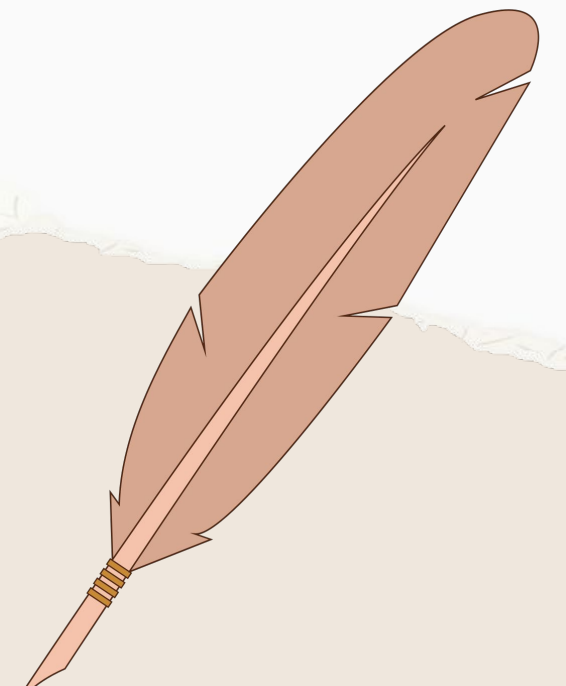
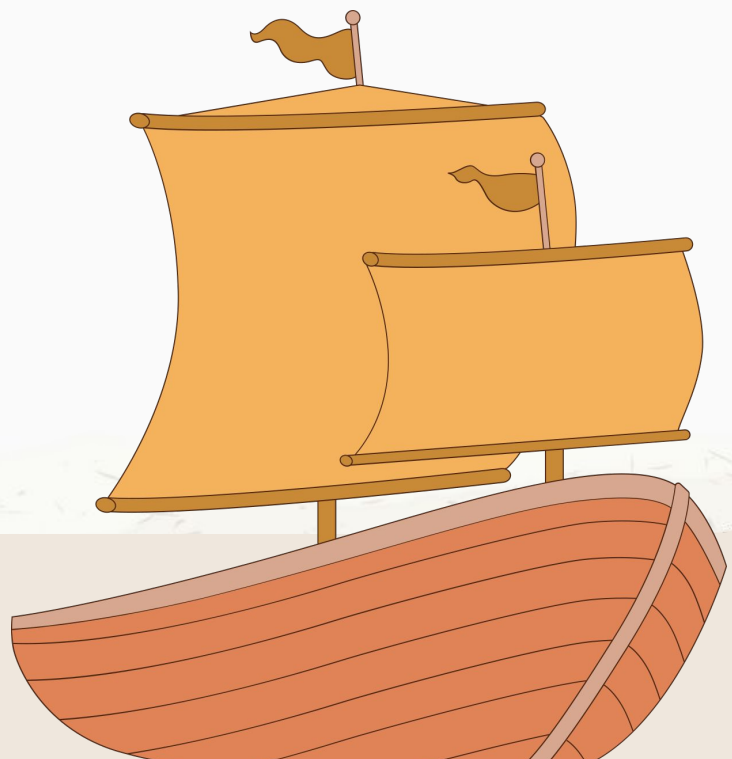

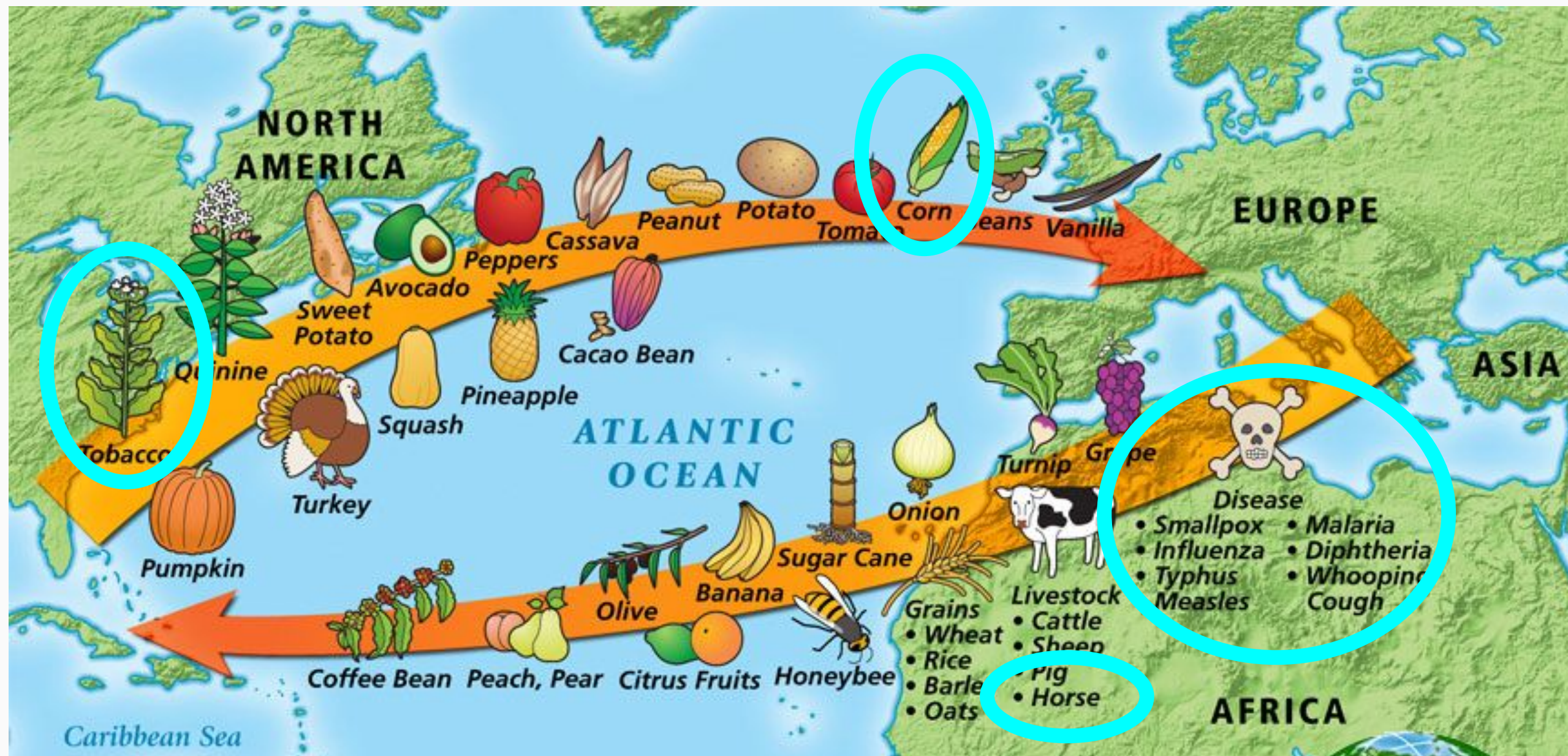

Christopher Columbus



- Born in Italy
- Went to King Ferdinand and Queen Isabel for money and ships to travel
- He knew the Earth was round, so he wanted to go west and find India and China to trade spices.
- Left Castilla in 1492
- First landed in the Bahamas
- Did not discover North America- Leif Erikson (a viking) found it first

Columbian Exchange



Native Americans



- Every region had different tribes, all with different cultures!
- There are 574 federally recognized tribes today!
- Biggest tribe: Navajo
- Over 300 languages were spoken
- Pocahontas, a daughter of a Chief in the Northeast, was real!!

Native American Life

- Some were hunters and gatherers, and others farmed!
 - Three big farm items: corn, beans, squash
- Great Plains Native Americans were mainly nomadic; they followed herds of American Bison
 - They lived in tepees, which are homes that can be moved from place to place.
 - Native Americans used all parts of the bison. They even used animal hides for the top of drums!



Influence

- Because of Native Americans, Europeans discovered tobacco, which is now used daily as the main ingredient in cigarettes
- 27 US states have names based on Native American words, including my state, Iowa!
