## Climate change

### A) The problem

### WHAT IS THE GREENHOUSE EFFECT?

Many **greenhouse gases**, e.g. carbon dioxide, methane and ozone, **exist**<sup>1</sup> naturally and are needed to **create**<sup>2</sup> the greenhouse effect that keeps the Earth warm enough to **support**<sup>3</sup> human life. However, the use of **fossil fuels**, e.g. **oil**, natural gas and coal, has produced **excessive**<sup>4</sup> amounts of greenhouse gases, and the **result**<sup>5</sup> is **global warming**: an increase in the average temperature on Earth. Of the 15 warmest years **on record**<sup>6</sup>, 14 have **occurred**<sup>7</sup> since 2000. The **effects**<sup>8</sup> of **climate change** can already be seen in our everyday lives. Summers are getting hotter and winters are getting wetter, so **drought**<sup>9</sup> and **floods**<sup>10</sup> are becoming more common. With it, animal and plant life is **suffering**<sup>11</sup> - some species will disappear altogether - and certain illnesses, e.g. hay fever, asthma and skin cancer, are becoming more common. To stop global warming from **destroying**<sup>12</sup> our **environment**<sup>13</sup>, we must act now.



## B) The **solution**<sup>14</sup> (or, part of it)

To **reduce**<sup>15</sup> global warming, the nations of the world will have to **act**<sup>16</sup> together. In the meantime, individuals can also help.

# SIX WAYS TO REDUCE GLOBAL WARMING:

- 1) Don't **throw** things **away recycle** paper, glass, plastic, etc. so that it can be used again.
- 2) Save<sup>17</sup> energy<sup>18</sup> e.g. switch off lights when you leave a room.
- Don't waste<sup>19</sup> water, e.g. turn off the tap when you are brushing your teeth.
- 4) Change **light bulbs** for more **energy-efficient**<sup>20</sup> ones.
- 5) Drive less and walk more.
- 6) Plant trees because trees reduce the amount of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere, and so reduce greenhouse gases.
