The Hungarian Revolution of 1956 was an important event in history. It started on October 23, 1956, when people in Hungary protested against Soviet rule. They wanted freedom and democracy. Students and workers joined together to demand change. At first, the government gave in to some of their demands. However, the Soviet Union sent tanks and soldiers to stop the revolution. Fighting broke out in Budapest and other cities. Thousands of people died, and many had to leave the country. The revolution ended on November 10, 1956, when the Soviet army took control. Although it failed, the revolution showed the world that people wanted freedom from communism.
